### Bible story:

Read the story of Josiah in 2 Kings 22-23 or in a children's bible -  
Josiah is often referred to as the boy king!

### Questions on the story:

How old was Josiah when he became king?

How old was he when he sent Shaphan to the temple?

What was the name of the high priest?

Who did Josiah want money to be given to?

What did Hilkiah find?

What did Josiah do when he heard the words from the  
book?

What did the people promise to do? 23 v 3

What did Josiah go around doing?

What event did the people celebrate?

2 Kings 23 v 25 says There was no king like Josiah before or  
after him. He obeyed the Lord with all his - - - - - , - - - - - and

Try and form 2 teams. Find some blocks, duplo or lego and have a race to see who can build the tallest tower in 1 minute. Then have a race to see who can take it down brick by brick in 30 s, then race building it back up in 30 s and then taking down in 15s!

## Talk about

Talk about the kings of Israel and how many would worship idols. A wicked king would reign and build up altars and create objects so the people would worship idols. A righteous king would reign and use his reign to tear down and destroy the wicked altars and idols. A wicked king would come back into power and rebuild the evil places of worship and then another good king would tear them down.

Have a look in 2 Kings 22 what did Josiah do that showed he fully loved and followed God.

## Make:



Make a scroll of the Torah to find, this can be a fun game of find the scriptures.

1. Cut a sheet of paper in half.
2. Crumple the pieces up to create wrinkles
3. Dip the paper in strong tea or coffee for about 30 seconds.
4. After the paper has dried put a small line of glue on the top and bottom.
5. Put a lolly stick/pencil over the glue to create ends to the scroll.
6. Write a favorite verse on your scroll.
7. Roll it up, tie a ribbon around and have fun playing hide and seek!






