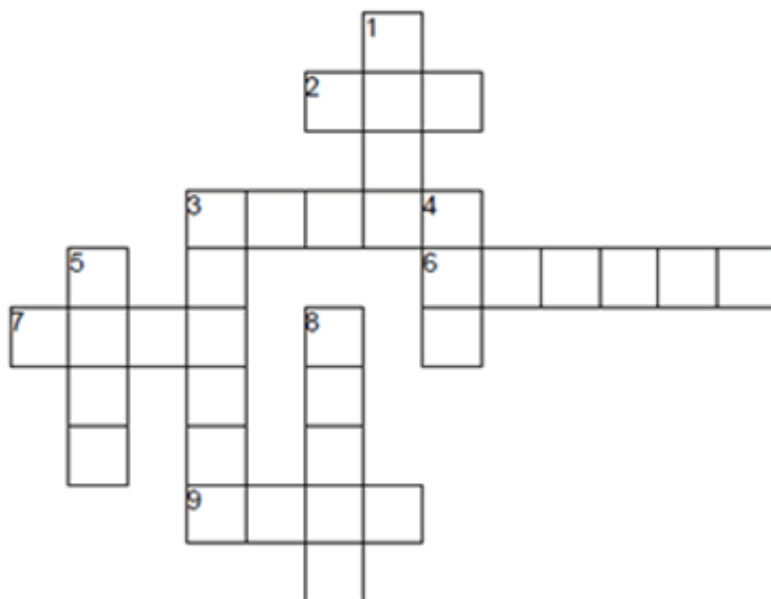


# The Parable of the Lost Son
